About the MSC Foundation

The MSC Foundation is a non-profit organization under German civil law that owns and oversees the Munich Security Conference (non-profit) limited. It was established in 2018 to ensure the independence and long-term sustainability of the Munich Security Conference and its growing activities in an era of geopolitical uncertainty. The MSC Foundation strives to provide a solid basis for the future development of the Munich Security Conference by leveraging its network and raising funds for the MSC Foundation's endowment.

Governance

The MSC Foundation's work is directed by the Foundation Council, which is led by the President of the MSC Foundation. The President currently also serves as Chairman of the Munich Security Conference. The Foundation Council appoints and supervises the members of the Board of Directors who handle the day-to-day operations of the MSC Foundation.

Funders that donate over 1 million euro to the MSC Foundation's endowment are invited to join the Board of Trustees, which advises the Foundation Council on strategic direction and future activities. Founding donors include the Governments of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Free State of Bavaria, multinational companies, private individuals and other foundations.

The MSC Foundation is also supported by its Advisory Council, which is composed of eminent thought leaders from politics and civil society who inspire and foster, support and represent the work of the Munich Security Conference.

Supporting the Foundation

Contributing to the Foundation allows companies, private individuals and other organizations to become part of a unique global network engaged in fostering dialogue and debate on the most important security challenges of our time. Supporters of the Foundation gain access to a tightly-knit community of influential decision makers and thought leaders. To facilitate donations and contributions for U.S.-based funders, the MSC has established a 501(c)(3) organization.
